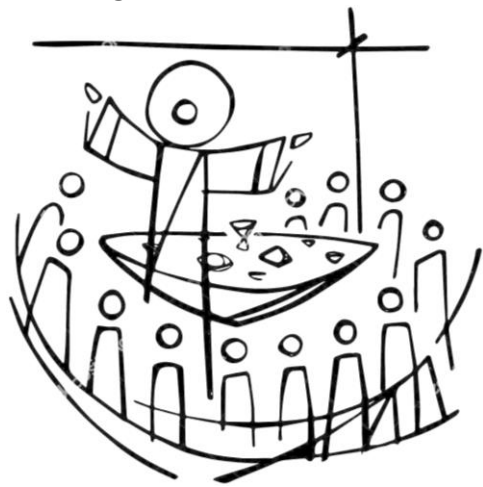
Lord's Prayer | Taizé 53
