

# Confirmation Verses

1. Genesis 28:15a: Know that I am with you, and will keep you wherever you go.
2. Deuteronomy 6:5: You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and will all your might.
3. Joshua 1:9: "Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened or dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."
4. Isaiah 43:1b: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.
5. Psalm 8:9: O Lord, our God, how majestic is your name in all the earth!
6. Psalm 19:14: Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.
7. Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.
8. Psalm 27:13-14: I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord.
9. Psalm 37:5: Commit you way to the Lord; trust him and he will act.
10. Psalm 46:1: God is our refuge and strength, a very present helping trouble.
11. Psalm 47:1 Clap your hands, all you peoples; shout to God with loud songs of joy.
12. Psalm 100:1-2: Make a joyful noise to the Lord all the earth. Worship the lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing.
13. Psalm 115:18: We will bless the Lord from this time forth and forevermore.
14. Psalm 119:105: Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
15. Psalm 121:8: The Lord will keep your going out and your coming in from this time on and forevermore.
16. Isaiah 40:31: Those who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.
17. Matthew 6:33: Strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
18. Matthew 20:28: The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many.
19. Matthew 22:37-38: "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'"
20. Matthew 28:19-20a: Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.
21. Matthew 28:20b: And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.
22. Mark 16:16: The one who believes and is baptized will be saved.
23. Luke 7:50: Your faith has saved you; go in peace.
24. Luke 19:10: For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost.
25. John 1:12: But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God
26. John 1:14: And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth.
27. John 3:16: For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.
28. John 8:31-32: If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.

29. John 11:25-26a: I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.
30. John 13:15: I have set you an example that you also should do as I have done to you.
31. John 13:34: I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another.
32. John 14:27: Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid.
33. John 15:4: Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me.
34. John 15:5: I am the vine you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing.
35. John 20:22b (Jesus) breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit."
36. Acts 1:8: But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.
37. Acts 2:38: Repent, and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
38. Acts 10:34b-35: I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him.
39. Romans 1:16: For I am not ashamed of the gospel; it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
40. Romans 3:23-24: Since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.
41. Romans 5:1: Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.
42. Romans 5:8: God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.
43. Romans 6:4: Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.
44. Romans 8:2: For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death.
45. Romans 10:9: If you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
46. Romans 10:17: So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ.
47. Romans 12:2: Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God.
48. Romans 12:9-10: Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honor.
49. Romans 12:12: Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer.
50. Romans 15:13: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
51. 1 Corinthians 1:3: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
52. 2 Corinthians 13:13: The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.
53. 1 Corinthians 6:19c-20: You are not your own. For you were bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body.
54. 1 Corinthians 13:11: When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways.

55. 1 Corinthians 13:13: And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.
56. 1 Corinthians 16:13-14: Keep alert, stand firm in your faith, be courageous, be strong. Let all that you do be done in love.
57. 2 Corinthians 5:19: In Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us.
58. Galatians 2:19b-20a: I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me.
59. Galatians 5:22: The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
60. Ephesians 2:8-9: For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God – not the result of works, so that no one may boast.
61. Ephesians 3:20-21: Now to him who by the power at work within us is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all we can ask or imagine, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
62. Ephesians 4:32: Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ has forgiven you.
63. Philippians 1:6: I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ.
64. Philippians 4:4: Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.
65. Philippians 4:6: Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
66. Philippians 4:8: Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.
67. 1 Thessalonians 5:18-20: Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
68. Hebrews 11:1: Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
69. Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us.
70. Hebrews 13:20-21a: Now may the God of peace, who brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, make you complete in everything good so that you may do his will.
71. 1 Peter 2:9: But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.
72. 1 Peter 5:7: Cast all your anxiety on (the Lord), because he cares for you.
73. 2 Peter 3:18: But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.
74. 1 John 4:7: Beloved, let us love one another, because love is from God; everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
75. Revelation 3:20: Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you, and you with me.
