TRAVEL INFORMATION


- We need to arrive in San Juan and depart San Juan at specific times to meet our hosts.
- Friday, June 14th – Leave for Chicago/MSP; spend the night
 - *Where we stay– TBD (depend on # of participants and cost research)*
- Depart Chicago/9:05am; Arrive San Juan at 3pm
 - Depart MSP/6:30am; Arrive San Juan at 3:13pm
- Saturday, June 21st – Arrive Chicago/6:57pm or MSP/10:01pm
- Travel back to La Crosse Saturday evening
 - **Notes: MSP is \$60 more and make 1 stop**
 - **Notes: ORD is nonstop**
 - **TBD at November mtg.**

TRANSPORTATION AND INTERNET ACCESS IN PUERTO RICO

Transportation on Mission Trip

- Travel by bus or van to ministry sites
- Fair amount of walking through the community

Calling Home and Internet Access

 - Mission trip experience is in part for full immersion in the culture.

 - PPM can not guarantee internet access.

FOOD AND LODGING


Food and Water

- 3 meals provided
- Welcome to bring small snacks in your bag (ex: protein bars, indiv. snack packs)

Lodging

- Variety of locations – we will stay as close as possible to community we are serving
- All locations safe, secure, adequate bathroom/shower facilities
 - Church, school, campground, guest houses
- Men and women will have separate lodging areas
- Floor sleeping (air mattress is an option)

REGISTRATION FEE COVERS....

- Praying Pelican ministry fee
 - Food
 - Lodging
 - Airfare
 - 1 check bag departing and returning
 - Van rental, gas, trip t-shirts

TRIP COSTS

- **\$1275.00 (approx.)**
 - Final cost TBD by December once logistics worked out
 - Monthly payments required to stay on track with our payment deadlines
- **Participants pay ½ and we fund raise for ½**
 - Youth receive \$100 from Youth & Family Team
 - Some of us may have connections that will help bring our cost down


TRIP COSTS **NOT** COVERED....YET

- Lodging the night before our flight
 - TBD as a group
- Extra activities we choose to participate in while there
- Shopping
- Airport snacks
 - Suggested amount to bring \$50-100

FUND RAISING

- Youth and Family Ministry Team will be giving each youth member of our congregation \$100 towards their trip.
- Scrip cards
- Registered participants will determine fund raising events through church at our 1st meeting in November
 - Include events for the church, the community, families, adults

ELC EXPECTATIONS

1. Everyone will participate in monthly meetings prior to the trip.
 2. Everyone will participate in fund raising for the trip.
 3. Everyone will contribute to the trip covenant prior to the trip.
 1. We are representing PPM and ELC
 2. No alcohol permitted.
 3. No drugs permitted.
 4. Very little cell phone use (Limitations TBD).
 5. We sign a PPM contract and abide by their rules.
