We are SO happy you are with us!

Our family-based program follows the lectionary (the scripture readings, children's sermon, and Pastor's sermon you will hear on the designated Sunday). Set aside approximately 30 minutes to participate as a family on Sunday morning before you watch our worship service to follow these FAITH5 steps:

1. Share Highs and Lows from the week
2. Read the Bible verse or story of the day
3. Talk about how this Bible reading might relate to you (or your highs/lows).
4. Pray for each other's highs/lows
5. Bless one another

Our Faith Milestone Program is also part of our program. Each packet is specific to the age of your children and their particular milestone or age. Look for those instructions separately. This will help your younger children stay occupied during worship and will provide your older children incentive to keep up with their Faith Milestones.

Step 1 - Share Highs/Lows

Each family member has a chance to tell the others something *GREAT* that happened to them or something they might be particularly proud of this week.

You also have a chance to share something that might have been a little sad or something that just did not go your way. This is a chance for your family to talk about what happened and find the best way to support each other.



Step 2 - Read the Bible verse or story of the day.
