On Sunday, February 11, an historic moment for English Lutheran Church took place at the annual congregational meeting. The congregation voted to officially register and publically identify as a Reconciling in Christ Lutheran congregation! There was a larger than normal turnout for the meeting. Of the 104 total ballots cast, 96 were in favor and 8 were against.

Reconciling in Christ churches advocate for full welcome and inclusion for all as equal members of our Christian family. By doing so, ELC committed to strengthening and enabling all of God's beloved to live authentic, visible, and faithful lives.


As a part of the decision, ELC has adopted the following Welcome Statement:

Holy Week

The end of March brings with it the time of great significance for those of us who follow Jesus Christ. Holy Week is when we walk with Jesus from death to life.



The Three Days

"Every Sunday in worship the church celebrates the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit gathers us to receive again the gifts of God that come to us through Christ, the saving Word. On several key days at the center of the church year, however, worship takes a particular shape. These central days have come to be known as the Three Days, recalling Jesus' own words to his disciples that he would be handed over to death, and that "after three days he will rise again" (Mark 10:34). The Three Days encompass the time from Maundy Thursday evening through the evening of Easter Day. In particular, the services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Vigil of Easter unfold in a single movement, as the church each year makes the passage with Christ through death into life." 

Paying Dividends

As most of you are aware, utility costs have increased considerably over the past few years. In 2021, English Lutheran embarked on a major HVAC project to address needs for replacing and upgrading our systems and tying them together into a single building automation system. I am pleased to say, we are seeing the positive results of the project.

Looking at year-over-year numbers, our Xcel Energy bills in fact went down from 2022-2023 by more than \$6,000, despite increasing energy rates and building use coming out of the pandemic. This trend is continuing, for the month of January 2024, our Xcel Energy bill went down by more than \$2,000 from 2023. Of course, average temperatures were warmer, but much of the decrease is directly attributable to more

efficient systems and better management of those systems.

Additionally, our water usage has decreased significantly, dropping by more than \$4,700 in 2023 vs. 2022. A chunk of that was due to the failure of the basement cooling system for the IT server, nonetheless, our usage was down every quarter of 2023.

We have Winona Controls to thank for their good work on the new HVAC systems.

Moving forward we will continue to look for opportunities for more savings through efficiency improvements.
