

Protocols for Volunteers for Indoor Worship during Covid-2021



All volunteers will be masked, wearing gloves when handing out anything, will sanitize their hands often, and remaining socially distanced.

We ask if any volunteer is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, had a recent positive diagnosis, or have recently been in contact with a known exposure that you do not sign up and stay home if you develop any symptoms the day you signed up to volunteer.

Volunteer Positions

Checking-in Greeter (3):

- One will be outside opening the door to have people enter the building.
- Two will be outside the prayer chapel checking people in and assigning a door people will enter into the sanctuary (Two stations; north sanctuary door will be closed until worship begins).
- Once everyone has arrived, sanitize surfaces used/touched.

If someone is unwilling to comply with mask wearing, we will ask them to leave, reminding them they can worship online. When all are checked in, volunteers may go into the sanctuary after washing/sanitizing their hands.

Sanctuary Greeter (1):

- One at a table outside the center sanctuary door handing out communion kits and children's church bags; encouraging people to remain socially distanced and keeping the line moving while wearing gloves.
- You will monitoring bathroom use, nursery traffic (when open), and not allowing guests to roam the building (with the assistance of the Worship Coordinator).

When all are in, volunteers may go into worship after removing their gloves and washing/sanitizing their hands.

Ushers in Sanctuary (2):

- Will seat families in the pews as space allows, reminding all that there will be no singing and to keep masks on mouth and nose at all times. Guests will be seated socially distanced.
- When worship is over, one usher will dismiss one section at a time (north section, middle section, then south section) front to back. One usher will be at the sanctuary doors moving people along encouraging social distancing. One usher will be at the parking lot doors moving people along encouraging social distancing.
 - All ushers will encourage congregating outside the church building.

When the service is over, **the check-in volunteer and sanctuary greeter** will stand in the narthex, discouraging people from congregating inside or venturing further into the building.

Following Worship:

All volunteers will help sanitize the narthex and sanctuary after the service. Cleaning checklist provided.
